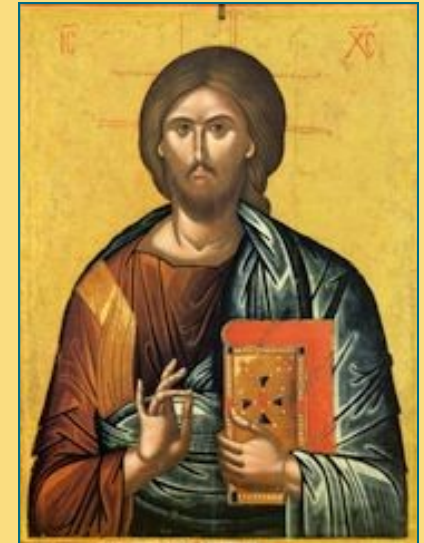

Christian Mysticism: History Wisdom and Insights

- The course surveys key figures of the Christian mystical tradition. It offers a unique opportunity to explore in depth the history and wisdom of Christian mysticism. It is a structured course taught by leading scholars of different Christian denominations.
 - Centering Prayer and Meditation are an integral part of the course, but previous experience is not necessary.
 - September 2009 begins the third year of a three-year course. Those who did not attend year one and/or two are eligible to attend year three. Participants register for one year at a time. The classes are held from September through May.
 - The **Colonial Hills United Methodist Church** hosts this course, usually on the first Saturday of each month, from 9:00 am through 12:00 pm. It is located at **5247 Vance Jackson, San Antonio, TX, 78230.**
 - The course is open to anyone of any spiritual tradition (or none) who wishes to explore Christian Mysticism seriously and in depth. No prior knowledge is required, but the course will best suit those who are prepared to give time for personal study. Registration is now open for the third year of the course.

Year 1, September 2007— May 2008 The first year dealt with the foundations of mysticism through the Middle Ages. The topics included an introduction to Christian Mysticism, The Foundations of Mysticism in the Jewish Scriptures, Mysticism in the New Testament: John & Paul, Desert Mothers and Fathers, Origen and Clement of Alexandria, Augustine of Hippo, Byzantine Spirituality, Benedict, and Celtic Spirituality: Bridget, Columba, and Patrick.

Year 2, September 2008 — May 2009 The second year focused on the mystics of the Middle Ages through early modern times. The topics included Franciscan Spirituality; Pseudo-Dionysius and Eastern Mysticism; Meister Eckhart and the German and Ryland Mystics; Julian of Norwich and the Cloud of Unknowing; Ignatian Spirituality; Dominican Spirituality; the French Mystics including Frances de Sales and Jane de Chantal; John of the Cross; and Teresa of Avila.
